### Welcome to Felpham Sailing Club.



We hope that you have an enjoyable time in the sunniest part of the UK (officially recognised!).

The water here is clean and the wind excellent. On sunny days we usually have a good, predictable sea breeze. We can launch at any height of tide time, and Felpham has an excellent safe beach for recovery. We own two high speed safety craft and have access to a fully equipped committee boat and further safety craft. Through our RYA RTC status we have a complement of qualified powerboat and safety boat drivers.

Registration begins at 11.00 on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> September with initial briefing at 11.30 and the first race at 13.00. A BBQ will be available from 17.00 – everyone is welcome to stay. **We are also pleased to confirm that the RNLI and Coastguard will be holding one of their excellent demonstrations off the beach from about 18.45.**

Breakfast will be served from 8.00 on Sunday morning, please give the kitchen notice on Saturday if you are likely to want breakfast.

If you require lunch on Sunday it should be ordered (and paid for) on Saturday, so that a rapid service can be provided. Lunches will also be available at the canteen as required. Please be patient as we have a small kitchen – giving advance notice of your needs is very helpful so that the kitchen crew can plan and provide for you at the right time.

Tea, coffee, hot chocolate, cakes, cold drinks & ices will be available from the hatch at competitive prices.

#### **Additional Information:**

The bar will be open during the afternoon & evening of both Saturday and Sunday. The kitchen will be open for lunch and tea on Saturday and breakfast & lunch from 8am on Sunday.

### **Important Notices to Competitors**

**Please be aware of the restricted access on the promenade. Please watch out for members of the public when manoeuvring boats to & from the beach.**

**Please use beach to the east of the ramp beach for the slow fleet and toppers and the west of the ramp for fast fleet.**

**Do not use the beach in front of the greensward – its rocky!**

**Please assist others with launch & recovery. There will, however be a limited Beach Crew.**

**Please follow advice from the Beach Crew.**

**The sailing area is shallow – full inversion is likely to result in the mast touching bottom.**

**A Security Guard will be on patrol from 11pm on Saturday through to 5 am Sunday. No responsibility can be taken for dinghies at the club or on the greensward.**

### **Advice is as follows:**

- **Arrive on Saturday at about 10.00 hrs onwards. You will be greeted by club members and members of WSSYSA who will take your boat to the greensward whilst you park the car.**
- **Register your arrival within the clubhouse with WSSYSA**
- **Canteen open for lunch from 11.00 hrs**
- **Briefing at 11.30 hrs in the clubhouse**
- **Rig dinghy and put on beach at about 12.15 hrs**
- **Day one races finish about 16.00 hrs**
- **BBQ starts at 17.00 hrs. Bar Open**
- **RNLI and Coastguard demonstration on Saturday evening from 18.45 hrs**
- **Please order Sunday's food on Saturday**
- **Arrive early on Sunday say 8.00 hrs ish**
- **Briefing at 9.00 hours with first race at 10.30 hrs**
- **Move your dinghy to the beach**
- **All dinghies to be on beach by 09.30 hrs latest**
- **Ensure space for others on the beach**
- **Help others launch – limited beach crew**
- **In the event of a postponement all dinghies to remain on the beach**
